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2. Information sur les composants

The product consists of cotton or viscose gauze or non woven viscose fabric (backing material) and alkyd resin (impregnation substance) with low content of plastisizer, which are usual paint materials and can be waste-managed as such.

Within the present knowledge of the supplier, this product does not contain any hazardous ingredients in quantities requiring reporting in this section, in accordance with EU or national regulations..

3. Identification des dangers

4. Description des premiers secours

Général: En cas de doute ou si des problèmes se persistent, contacter un médecin.

Ingestion: Na inslikken onmiddellijk een arts raadplegen. Niet overgeven.

Hantering:
